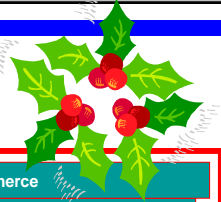

CHRISTMAS SHOPPING FAIR: DECEMBER 10-11TH TIME TO SHOP HERE AT HOME!



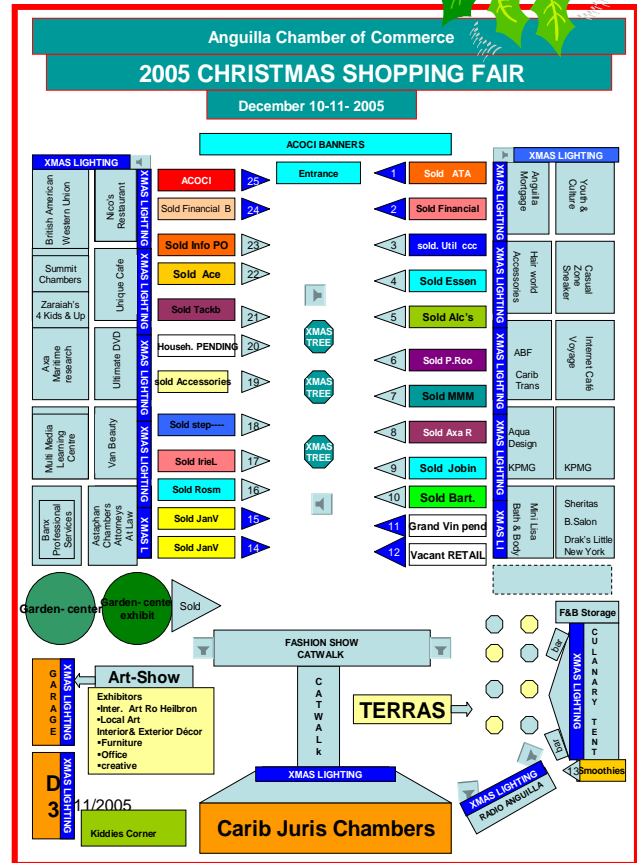
